Individual Study Options & Tutors

CESL offers several individualized options if your schedule does not allow you to join a regularly scheduled class or if you would like extra help.

1. Individual General English Instruction: Tutors customize language for your personal language needs. We offer many different kinds of tutoring:

- General Tutoring:* This tutoring is mainly for CESL students or undergraduate students who would like help with general English skills.
- Elite Tutoring:* This tutoring is mainly for students who are in graduate programs or who are professionals. Elite tutors have more specialized experience in academic and professional areas.

(Minimum of 10 hours for these tutoring options.)

2. Tutoring Packages: These packages focus on particular English skills. The tutors for these packages are CESL teachers. In addition to 10 hours of tutoring, students receive additional materials (such as books, CDs, or training on computer programs) to help them progress quickly in the area they choose.
