### **TO ENTER**

Complete this form and attach a hard copy of your artwork and a disk version. All submissions must include the following:

- artwork suitable for a 9x6 inch book cover, not posters (i.e. must look good foiled);
- 6 spot graphics for chapter headings (winner will be asked to produce 12 more), approximately 1.5x1.5;
- 3 spot graphics for section headings, approximately 3.5x3.5;
- book title (*A Student's Guide to First-Year Writing*, 27<sup>th</sup> edition); year (2006-2007); University of Arizona trademark; editor's names (Jennifer deWinter, Jim Bowman, and Andrea Modarres); Space for an ISBN bar code and the logo for Hayden-McNeil Publishing.
- The final version of the artwork should be turned in on a zip disc or a CD.

Entrants should keep in mind that the primary audience for the book is UA undergraduates and faculty. Writing professionals at other colleges/universities, parents, and members of the wider UA community should be considered as secondary audiences.
